Why Don't You Become A Texas Notary?

It's as Easy as 1-2-3

1. Download and complete the state required [notary application](#).

Please print the following application. NOTE: Make sure that the bond is printed on ONE SHEET of plain paper (back/front) or the State of Texas WILL NOT accept the application

2. Mail the completed application & \$71.00 Bond Fee:

3. Simply wait a few weeks for your state commission to arrive!

Other important information

1. Please complete the application in BLACK INK, the state will not accept the application in any other color ink (we're serious!)
2. Please sign the application in THREE places.
3. This is the same application for a NEW notary commission and a RENEWAL commission.
4. Once you receive the notary commission from the State of Texas you must: 1) Have a notary log book (which can be purchased at any office supply store) 2) Purchase a notary seal (this can be rubber or a metal seal), for a quote look in the local yellow pages under the heading "rubber stamps".

5. The notary commission is good for 4 years!
